Form:	If	I	won	the lottery	I	would	buy
	Conjunction	Subject	Past Simple	Object	Subject	Modal	Base verb
	If + past participle + would + base verb						
Meaning:	To talk about unlikely hypothetical future scenarios						
Context:	Give students a lottery ticket and tell them to imagine they are the winning numbers. Teacher should say "If I won the lottery I would buy a new car". Students should give some examples too.						
CCQs:	Will I win the lottery? Is it likely I will win the lottery? Did I win the lottery? What would I do if I really had the winning ticket tomorrow?

Sentence #7	Candidates should be able to speak fluent German.						
Form:	Should be able						
	Modal phrase that means "ought to"						
	... + should + base form + ...						
Meaning:	To indicate a requirement that is desirable						
Context:	A copy of an Ad that uses the phrase "should be able". Read the ad to the students and then show it to them. Tell the students you don't speak German.						
CCQs:	Should I apply for the job? Can I apply for the job? Will I apply for the job? Is it important for the candidates to speak German? Is it essential they speak German? Is it desirable they speak German? Is it obligatory they speak German?
