

## Sample Tasks for Students' Portfolio

- Choose a product you are interested in (for example Tea) then write a short text (200 words) on what you like about the product, flavor, where it is made, how much it costs, etc
- Design a questionnaire for your classmates so you can find out things like, how many of your classmates like tea too, what type of tea, how much they spend on tea, etc
- Interview your classmates [and write down what their responses are to the questions you ask]. It is better if you write it down rather than just giving a form to students to fill out, you are practicing speaking with speakers of a similar level to you
- Review your results and write a 200 word short text on your findings, commenting on things like, some students prefer fruit tea, some prefer Chinese tea, some spend five euro per week on tea, and so on
- (At the end of your text) write down 5 different things you would like to find, such as, “what is the best Chinese tea for me”, “what diffuser to use”, “where can I buy the best tea in Dublin”, etc
- Go about finding this information out by asking native speakers in a retail environment, for example, maybe one student told you they drink a certain blend of Chinese tea to help them sleep, maybe you can go ask about that in the relevant store
- Write a 200 word reflection on the speaking cycle outlined above
