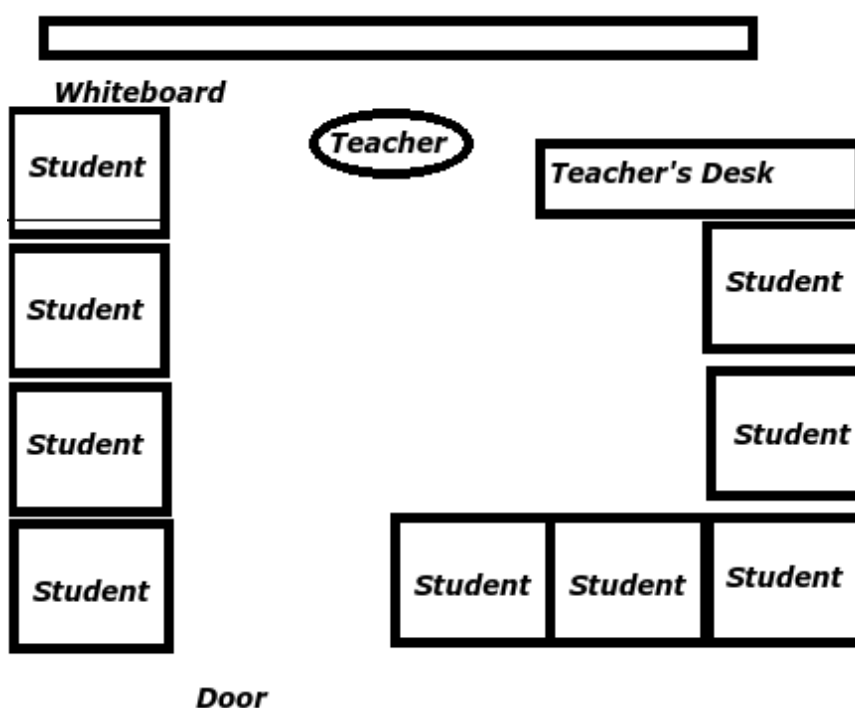


# Observation of Writing Class (B1)

The lesson is prepped with a class discussion about films. The students are explained the concept of "Genre" and the teacher elicit some genres from them. So the lesson starts as as T-Ss. A impressive range was given by the students (Horror, Western, Sci-fi, Triller, Action, Comedy, Rom-Com, Fantasy, Drama, Animation). Some error correction took place which was done very well. An Italian student had a word order problem. That is, confusing fact based movie with based-on-facts / factual / based on a true story.

Students are given a pair-work writing task. They are told they need to work in pairs and to write a script of movie. They are to combine their ideas into one script. They were clearly instructed and given guide line points. They were told to choose a genre, choose where to set it, the location, the clothes and so on.
