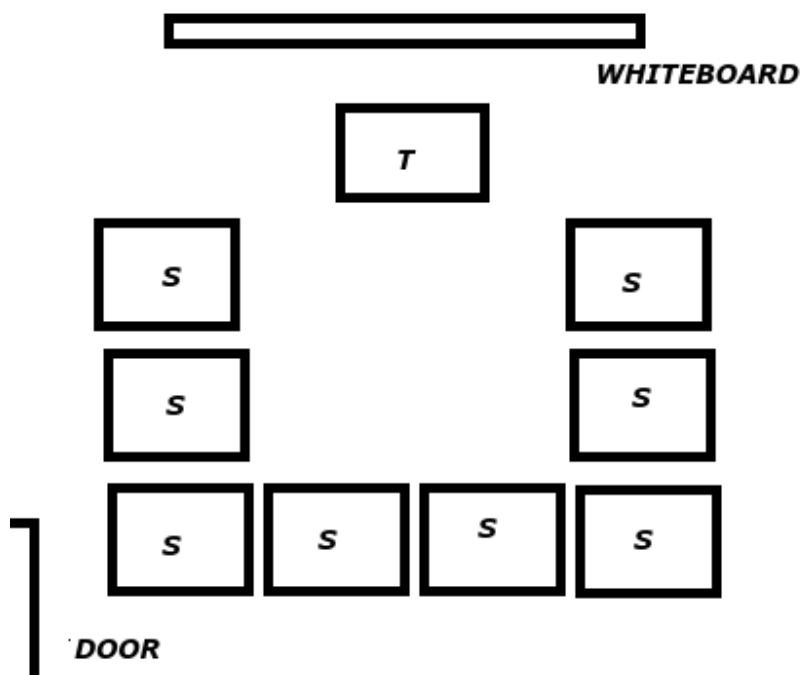


## Observation of Vocab Class (A2)

The students were quite a bit younger for this lesson, likely because it was A2. I was observing the second half of a lesson. The students had a worksheet done and the teacher was going through the answers. In the first question the students needed to understand the difference between slim and skinny, the explanation was clear and to the point. The follow questions continued the theme of distinguishing between words of similar but different meaning, for example, older vs elder.

Following on from this was stressing the suffix in words such as employee (oO) and employer (oO), the students were making a mistake in pronouncing it. The error correction was done by the teacher and was followed by some drilling.

Further mistakes made by the students were verbally corrected by the teacher. And the correction was re-enforced by board work.
