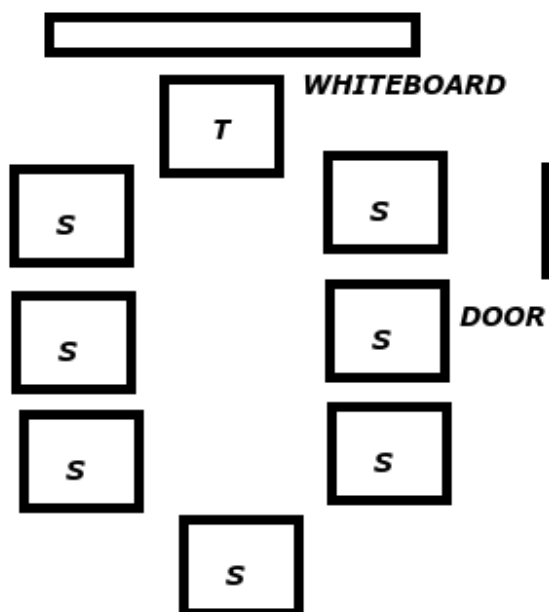


## Observation of Grammar Class (B2)

This lesson was a revision lesson of some grammar points the students were working on. They had to practice putting into adverbs and time. For example: We're going to be unfortunately late → Unfortunately, we're going to be late. Etc. Students were given a worksheet and were asked to work on it by themselves. After 10 minutes the students were then asked for the answer and as such some issues came up. Most of the students seem to understand the explanation. For example one student from Portugal had trouble with “I want to do less work” vs “I want to work less” .

During the the lesson some Real questions and some Display questions came up. Since this was the second half of a double lesson I did not see any real questions had the start... that is “What did you do last night” style of questions. However some Real questions did come up.
