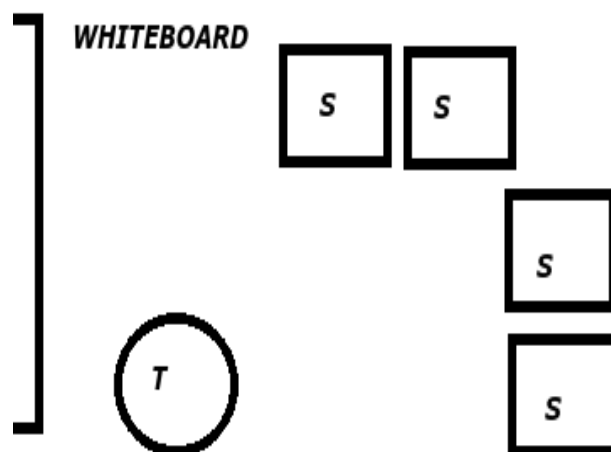


## Observation of Vocab Class (A1)
