- **Was it all Teacher/Student or did you have some pairwork?** I gave an appropriate amount of time to Ss-Ss work
- **Was your timing/amount of material too much / too little / just right?** I ran a little bit over, 35 minutes instead of 30 minutes
- **Were t he students of a level higher / lower / just as expected?** Yes they were at the level I expected and planned for
- **Which skills did you deal with listening / speaking / reading / writing?** Vocab via listening and speaking (with some writing)
