<b>Title:</b>	eBay
<b>Name:</b>	Stephen Easley-Walsh
<b>Level:</b>	B1
<b>Date &amp; Time:</b>	2/09/14 14:00
<b>Room:</b>	110
<b>Number of Ss:</b>	3
<b>Aim:</b>	<i>By the end of this lesson Ss will have developed their writing skills in the context of placing eBay Ads.</i>
<b>Language Items:</b>	Vocab related to selling, in particular selling online.
<b>Lexical Items:</b>	Auction, Auctioneer, Condition, Description
<b>Phonology:</b>	(E is pronounced separately) /'i:beɪ/
<b>Materials:</b>	Hand-outs + mp3
<b>Personal Aims:</b>	Delivering a "Writing" (Integrated) class

<b>Stage:</b>	Setting Context – Warm up	<b>Format:</b>	T-Ss	<b>Time:</b>	0-2
<b>Procedure:</b>	T is to ask Ss what is the last thing they bought online.				
<b>Aim:</b>	Setting the context.				
<b>Anticipated Problems:</b>	None.				

<b>Stage:</b>	Setting Context – Listening Activity	<b>Format:</b>	Ss-Audio	<b>Time:</b>	3-4
<b>Procedure:</b>	Play the Auctioneer.mp4 – Ss are to identify what they are listening to.				
<b>Aim:</b>	Setting the context.				
<b>Anticipated Problems:</b>	Ss may not understand what is being said in the mp4 but they may recognize the "sound" of it as being an Auction.				

<b>Stage:</b>	Setting Context – Listening Activity II	<b>Format:</b>	Ss-Audio	<b>Time:</b>	5-6
<b>Procedure:</b>	Play the mp4 once more but tell the Ss (this should be written on the board) they are to listen out for (a) <b>what</b> was sold (b) <b>how much</b> did it sell for and (c) <b>who</b> it was sold to. Afterwards the T can give the answer to the Ss.				
<b>Aim:</b>	Fun little activity to get the class going also it helps the Ss to "scan" for keywords in an listening.				
<b>Anticipated Problems:</b>	Ss may be put off the task because it seems too difficult but if they understand the format of an auction they may succeed
